The Success 4 Kids Council was created May 2001 for the primary purpose to undertake activities in furtherance of prevention of child abuse. The Success 4 Kids Council is a 501 (c) (3) nonprofit corporation under the Iowa Nonprofit Corporation Act, Chapter 504A, Code of Iowa. The mission of the Success 4 Kids Council is "To prevent child abuse in Adair County."

Early Childhood Committee Purpose:

The Adair County Early Childhood Committee shall be the standing advisory committee for the 4 R Kids Early Childhood Iowa Area Board. Community partners, agencies, citizens and Board members may participate; participation is not limited to any agency or person. The 4 R Kids Early Childhood Iowa Area Board may refer specific issues/tasks to this committee. Tasks may include but not limited to, provide expertise in fields of health, human services, early care and education; suggest public policy; provide guidance on community needs and issues; and advocacy for the early childhood Iowa area.

The Adair County Early Childhood Committee is combining efforts with the Success 4 Kids Council. This will reach a wider network of stakeholders that will increase community collaboration among many agencies. There will be a focus on early childhood as well as other age groups.
