Legislative Update

Legislative language has been added to the school ready funds to eliminate the restrictive categorical funds. It appears as though there will be about an 8% reduction in the early childhood funding and a 5% reduction in the school ready funding.

Toddlerfest

Ameri Health Caritas provided \$500 to cover the meal and the face painting, DCAT provided \$950 to cover the super heros, venue, face painting and materials, and 4 R Kids provided \$81.78 for books/materials.
