During this quarter, the Program lost one .375 FTE Educator in August and another Educator has taken a leave of absence from Sept to November 2014. Prior to taking her leave, the Educator did complete 34 visits, all required reports and made arrangements for services (if required) for all of her families. One other .25FTE Educator has experienced significant health issues and was not able to perform to her capacity for a period of time. A significant number of families exited due to aging out of the program prior to July 1, 2014. We have had very positive momentum in enrolling new families in Madison County due to increased visibility and outreach efforts. We are partnering with Head Start in Madison County to offer parenting education and are also collaborating with other community partners for referrals and service coordination. We are in the process of searching for a Parent Educator to replace the Educator who left during this quarter and anticipate having someone identified and hired before year-end. The addition of a Program Supervisor has been extremely positive. She is providing the required reflective supervision for staff, as well as, working to make certain that the Program is meeting all required PAT Model Standards and also all of the standards for the lowa Family Support Credential. In addition she is the contact person for Program referrals. The plans for the implementation of Blockfest are underway. The team has been trained and certified, an exhibit has been purchased and will be delivered in October and all required licensure, contracts and agreements have been completed.
