Early Childhood Updates/Information

- The 4 R Kids ECI board is looking for board members, contact Deb Schrader if you know of someone. The 4 R Kids Board has been meeting with candidates running for House and Senate and after the election will plan to have a lunch and learn to bring awareness of early childhood and is looking for a business to partner with.
- Samra Hiros presented on the action plan goals for Dallas County this fiscal year. The American Lung Association is working on the following initiatives in Dallas County: tobacco-free and nicotine-free worksites, ISTEP chapter formation, increasing Quitline Iowa numbers, and coalition development. ALA staff suggested drafting a letter for tobacco retailers who passed a Synar compliance check in Dallas County. ALA notified the coalition that they presented to the Waukee High School administration on the trends of electronic cigarettes, particularly the Juul brand. Staff also talked about the 2016 Iowa Youth Survey results as they pertain to Dallas County. See attached written report.
- CCRR provided a presentation about the changes with child care assistance as well as the FY18 report, 14% of child care providers have a QRS rating.
- <u>Iowa Early Childhood Systems Summit</u> is October 3 ,2018 from 9:00-5:00, additionally there will be a celebration from 5:00-7:00, both events are located at the Sheraton Hotel in Des Moines. Total cost for both events is \$105.

The American Lung Association holds the Community Partnership grant funded by the Iowa Department of Public Health, Division of Tobacco Use Prevention & Control for eight counties in Iowa. We serve Adair, Dallas, Jasper, Madison, Marshall, Polk, Union, and Warren Counties and follow best practices for tobacco control outline by the CDC:

- 1. Prevent the Initiation of tobacco use among young people
- 2. Eliminate non-smokers exposure to secondhand smoke
- 3. Promote quitting among young people and adults
- 4. Identify and eliminate tobacco-related disparities among population groups.

FY2019 Initiatives for Dallas County

Tobacco & Nicotine-free Worksites: Goal 0/3

The 2018 IYS is currently in production. Students will be answering the survey questions this fall for 2018 IYS.

2016 Iowa Youth Survey:

Notable findings:

- 14% of Dallas 11th Graders reported current E-cigarette use (Iowa average: 9%)
- 31% of Dallas 11th Graders have ever used E-cigarettes (lowa average: 25%)
- 9% of Dallas 11th Graders reported current tobacco use (Iowa: 10%)
- 18% of Dallas 11th Graders have ever used tobacco products (lowa: 19%)

2016 BRFSS:

- Among adult lowans in 2016, 16.7 percent reported being a current smoker. This is a decrease from the 18.1 percent found in 2015 and is the lowest ever seen in the state.
- In 2016, 4.3 percent of all lowa adults currently used e-cigarettes. Use of e-cigarettes is particularly common among the young, less educated, lower income and males.
