
# Warren County Early Childhood Committee

**Legislative Update** – Several child care bills are still alive and ECI is monitoring them. SF2366 is a bill that requires those receiving public assistance must work 20 hours or volunteer 20 hours a week in order to receive assistance, there is support for this in the Senate.
