- The Association of Early Childhood Iowa Area Board and Advocates is finishing the last touches on the legislative agenda and it will be shared at a later date.
- The preschool experience rate is currently being collected from all school districts in the 4 county area, at this time Warren County's rate may be close to 90%, the goal is 90%.

Other

- Betsy Stursma provide an update on the federal CARES funding that is available through CICS, applications are found on line at CICS website. Additionally CICS is working on a work plan.
- 1st Five had 4 new referrals; there will also be an ASQ training for health care providers.
- EFR is working a "responsible gifting campaign" and sought input from the group where marketing could be done.
- The ACEs report is available and is now broken down by regions and not by specific county data.
- The presidential Election was 11-3-20 and the election has yet to identify a president, President Donald Trump or Vice-President Joe Biden. Other results were; Senator Joni Ernst will retain her Federal Senate seat; Brooke Boden beat incumbent Representative Scott Ourth for house district 26; Representative Stan Gustafson will retain house district 25 and Representative Kristin Sunde will retain house district 42.
