- Coalition Updates:
  - Agenda accepted
  - Last month's minutes accepted and filed
  - Subgroup Updates:
    - 4 R Kids Early Childhood Committee (Debra Schrader)
      - Warren County will receive \$9.9 million in Corona State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds. Larger cities will also receive funding such as West Des Moines at \$7.7 million and Des Moines at \$94.8 million. The funds are to address one or more of the following:
        - Support public health response
        - o Address the negative economic impacts of public health emergency
        - Serve the hardest hit communities/families
        - Replace lost public sector revenue
        - Provide premium pay for essential workers
        - Invest in water and sewer infrastructure
        - Invest in broadband infrastructure

- The 4 R Kids ECI board will release an RFP in Collaboration with Quad Counties 4 Kids for a Prenatal Advantage Pilot Program this fall. The intent is to improve birth outcomes as well as increase referrals to ECI family support programs.
- 2020 Child abuse data was reviewed, Warren county has 63 children under the age of 5 and 53 over the ages 6-17 and ranks 78th in state on rate of abuse.
- Medicaid birth data was reviewed, 24.6% of 2019 births were paid by Medicaid. The highest percentage was Woodbury County at 63.2%.
- Warren County population data was reviewed, Currently the Warren County population is 52,370 which is a growth of 452 from the previous year.

    County and will start filling those with cold items, sandwiches, produce and more
    next week. They are located at Lacona Community Center, MILO Locker, Simpson
    College, Indianola Public library, New Virginia Public Library and Truro Public
    Library. We have other communities that are thinking about adding them but
    wanted to wait and see how the program was working out in other communities
    before opting in.

- Need Diapers? Monthly Pick-Up: The Warren County Diaper Bank is available to any Warren County family who meets the income requirement. Diaper pick-up is every fourth Thursday of the month from 4:30-6:30. Registration is required.

  - Only the parent or legal guardian may request diapers.
  - We cannot accommodate requests for specific brands of diapers.
  - We make every effort to accommodate diaper sizes Newborn to 6, although availability is limited to stock on hand. Please make sure you register each month to guarantee size availability.
  - Diapers distributed may not meet all your diaper needs; this program is intended to be supplemental.
  - We ask that you wear a mask and stay in your vehicle on pick-up day due to social distancing. Short Years Partnership staff or volunteers will assist you.
