- > 4 R Kids Early Childhood Committee Update (Debra Schrader)
 - Lead: Deb Schrader (4rkidseci@gmail.com)
 - The 4 R Kids Board gathers data from all school districts in Adair, Dallas, Madison and Warren County regarding the preschool experience rate. Warren County kindergarteners preschool experience rate was 87.5% and the overall for the areas is

- 87.5%. Schools also noted that children are not coming to school ready and behavior and need for social interactions are a top need.
- The 4 R Kids ECI board is supporting the Association of Early Childhood Iowa Area Boards legislative agenda; maintain local control and unique nature of ECI, support a compressive integrated early care, health and education system, and develop systemic solutions to child care. The Association's FY22 annual report was also shared.
- Information was shared about the \$20 million for housing in Iowa through the State Home Grant Program.
- o No new information on the HHS alignment.
- The legislative makeup has changed since the election, there will be 36 democrats and 64 republicans in the house and 16 democrats and 34 republicans in the Senate starting January 1, 2023
- o A report from Common Good Iowa was shared about the wage theft in Iowa.
