Early Childhood Updates/Information

- The 4RKids Board has Dallas County position open on the board.
- Recommendations on the changes to 19 programs that run through HHS should be available around mid-October.
- Iowa Boards and commissions recommendations were reviewed, the state ECI board will remain, 111 boards of 257 will be eliminated.
- The Dallas County early childhood services map was reviewed and changes made where necessary.
- The Dallas County family support map was reviewed and changes made where necessary.
- Data on Latinos in Iowa was reviewed, Dallas County 6.5% Latino population, the county with the highest Latino population is Crawford County with 29.7%
- Data was reviewed regarding brightwheel and Playground technology, 31% of child care providers are using technology grants. There are 6 counties in Iowa who are not participating.
- A list of child care incentives was reviewed.
- A child care workforce study conducted by Iowa AYEC and I2D2 was reviewed. Recommendations included are, sustainable ways to raise wages; employee benefits; good work environment; data collection and misunderstandings of child care businesses.

- The FY23 DCCAC executive summary was shared with the group.
- The FY24 1st quarter report will be due soon.
- The 990's for 2021, 2022 and 2023 have filed with the IRS.
