## Early Childhood Updates/Information

- The 4 R ECI board will meet November 20, 2025.
- The state ECI board meet in a working session to discuss ECI moving into 7 regions. No decisions were made and at this time it is voluntary to merge into regions. Some areas are submitting a letter of intent to build regions.
- The current Thrive pilot in Warren County will end December 31, 2025 and new service called Restore Hope will be funded with a contact with HHS. An RFP is out from HHS for Restore Hope.
- A document with PCA navigation and DAP navigation was provided to the group.

# Dallas County Children's Advocacy Council Updates/Information

- The 1<sup>st</sup> quarter report was provided; sexual abuse prevention 1 session with 14 adults served, SWCC home visitation 3 families served; Short Years Partnership 11 families served. A total of \$19,459.14 was expended in the first quarter.
- The August and September claims have been submitted.
- Treasurers report there is 2,766.99 in the bank account.
- An executive committee member is needed to represent Madison County.
- Val Cameron continues to facilitate aspects of the grant.
