Announcements and Information

- **Legislation** - A legislative update regarding several bills was reviewed. SF2488 has been signed by the Governor which eliminates ECI, DCAT, CPPC, and PCA and requires a study of ECI. Information was shared about SF2422, it will add 40 new state FTEs and cost \$9.3 million.
- **DCAT and CPPC** will close its doors effective June 30th.
- **Meetings** - The Madison County Kids Coalition and Madison County Cares will merge together as one meeting starting August 25, 2026 at 11:00 at the Winterset School Admin Building.
- **Election** – Results of the primary election were reviewed.
- **I2D2** - indicator data was reviewed by the group and feedback was sought. There are 26 indicators tracked, the top five needing improvement are domestic violence, preterm births, preterm or low birth weight, dental services and children with health coverage. The strongest indicators are educational attainment of mothers, immunized children, early literacy skills, children in poverty and cumulative birth risks. It is important to note the indicators are group as a four-county effort, Adair, Dallas, Madison, and Warren County.
- **ECI Service Types** - The group reviewed the current ECI service types that are allowed to be funded in ECI.
- **Co-Location Grant** - The statewide communities of care co-location for rural areas grant were reviewed. Iowa PCA is provided technical assistance for the grant.
- **Opioid Funding** – Information was shared on the Opioid funding for FY24, programming was provided; \$145,239 was carried over to the next year.
- **Kids Count Data** – Iowa data was shared with the group. Areas of improvement were 4th and 8th grade reading, high school graduation and chronic absenteeism.
- **Dallas County Children’s Advocacy** - will have an executive meeting June 11th; an executive member is needed for Adair and Madison County. There will be a budget amendment to add \$250 dollars per family served for home visitation.
- **Child Abuse Data** - FY25 Child abuse data was shared; there were 76 reports in Madison County with 38 confirmed and founded.
